Dear Ranking Member Garcia:

Thank you for your letter to Chevron Corporation (jointly with its affiliates, “Chevron” or “Company”) regarding the evolving situation in Venezuela. Your letter requests information regarding advance notice of the recent US military operation in Venezuela, as well as information regarding Chevron’s activities in Venezuela.

As to the first issue, Chevron did not have advance notice of the recent US military operation in Venezuela.

As to Chevron’s activities in Venezuela, Chevron has invested in the country for over 100 years and remains committed to beneficial and productive activities as permitted by applicable laws. Chevron affiliates have long held interests in five onshore and offshore projects in Venezuela, through joint ventures with affiliates of Petróleos de Venezuela, S.A., Venezuela’s national oil and gas company, which is the operator of each of these projects. Both Democrat and Republican Administrations have supported Chevron’s continuing investment in Venezuela and recognized its importance for the United States as well as for Venezuela. For example, Chevron received approval by the Biden Administration in November 2022 to expand its production and export of oil from Venezuela. Chevron’s significant capital and social investments in Venezuela have helped develop the national workforce and promoted the beneficial use of local resources over many decades.

As it does everywhere in the world where it has projects, Chevron advocates for sound and appropriate public policy and anticipates continuing to do so in Venezuela. Chevron also aims to strengthen local communities with programs that deliver measurable and sustainable results. In the past 19 years, Chevron’s social investment contributions in Venezuela totaled more than \$133 million, benefiting over 1.5 million Venezuelans with health, education, and economic development programs.


