

## Appendix IV: Unreported Foreign Gifts Received by Jared Kushner

The Committee has edited foreign donor names and titles for common usage and consistency in the appendices. The Committee also corrected misspellings found in the original records or conducted research to complete any missing information, such the titles of foreign government officials. The “Year Received” may reflect NARA’s record for entering appraisal data for gifts into its artifact management system, which may not be the same year for when the gift was given and received. NARA stated that many foreign and domestic gifts were turned over to them after the end of the Administration, resulting in a date recorded in 2021.
