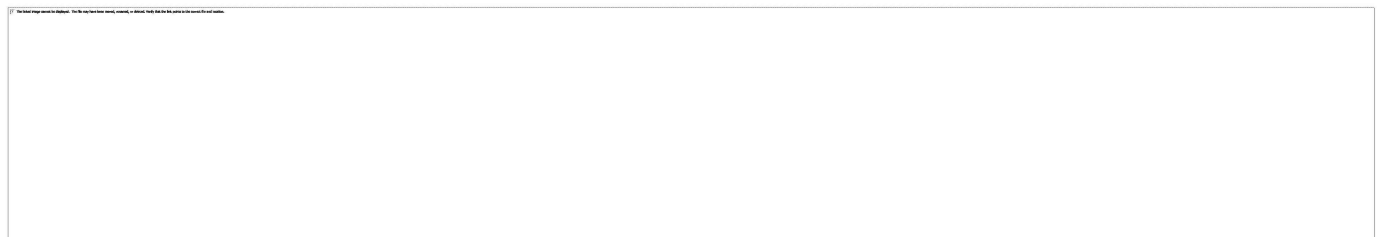

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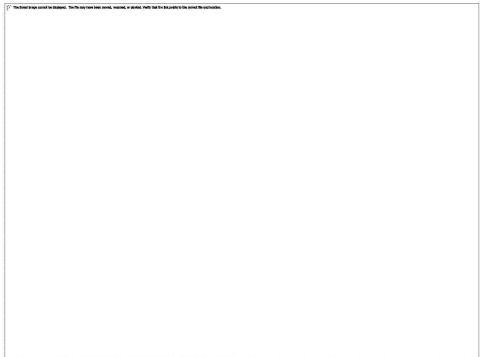

## The Trump EPA – Some Things to Expect

With just a few weeks before President-elect Trump's inauguration, and his recent nomination of Oklahoma Attorney General Scott Pruitt as EPA Administrator—a leading critic and challenger of the Waters of the United States Rule (WOTUS Rule) and the Clean

Power Plan (CPP)—the era of the Trump EPA is set to begin. Much has already been written on some of the expected environmental policy changes under the Trump era EPA, such as attempting to dismantle the CCP, modifying the WOTUS Rule, and approving the Keystone XL pipeline.

Beyond these headline grabbing policy changes, however, are some other significant implications for the regulated community. Three areas of particular interest are the role of EPA initiated enforcement actions and citizen suits, opportunities to drive and shape EPA's environmental priorities, and the future pace and substance of EPA's implementation of the recent amendments to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA).

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
