Thanks Dominic and Paul. CLC's analysis suggests that the carbon fee they are supporting — starting at \$40 a ton (in 2017\$) and increasing annually at 5% over inflation — will cut US carbon emissions in half by 2035 versus 2005. They plan to reference this in the updated Pillars document on their website, which now will exclude the prior reference to liability relief. They also are adding a specific reference in the Pillar on regulatory simplification to the preemption of current and future stationary source carbon regulations, which puts some further meat on the bones.

CLC delivered to me late Friday (in hard copy) their revised Pillar document and a comms plan for rollout of this (including esp removal of the liability relief provision). They plan to roll this out next week. I will send that along soon to you and others for awareness. Bottom line, XOM has apparently agreed to this plan at least for now and so crisis averted in terms of XOM on one side or Microsoft on the other making a noisy withdrawal over the liability issue.

Ted Halstead did approach me last week to ask about CLC arranging meetings with companies and ENGOs on the margins of the OGCI meeting. I was a bit cool to this as there did not seem like a natural space for it, plus while XOM seems to be staying with CLC for now I am not sure how enthusiastic they (or Shell) would be about participating in a big public campaign by CLC around the UN events at this time.

Let me know your thoughts and also happy to set a time to discuss.
