RESOLUTION

Of inquiry requesting the President transmit certain documents in his possession to the House of Representatives relating to the security clearances held by Elon Musk, members of the United States Department of Government Efficiency Service, and any other individual considered to be a member of the DOGE team.

- 2 to the extent that such documents are in the possession
- 3 of the President, to the House of Representatives, not
- 4 later than 14 days after the adoption of this resolution,

3 background investigations of, and security clearance held
4 by individuals employed by, contracted with, or otherwise
5 working with, in an official or unofficial capacity, the
6 United States DOGE Service (commonly referred to as the
7 “Department of Government Efficiency” or “DOGE”) or
8 any DOGE agency team, including—

- 9 (1) Elon Musk;
- 10 (2) Akash Bobba;
- 11 (3) Edward Coristine;
- 12 (4) Ethan Shaotran;
- 13 (5) Luke Farritor;
- 14 (6) Gautier Cole Killian; and
- 15 (7) Gavin Kliger.
