1	SEC. 2. ESTIMATES OF AGGREGATE ECONOMIC GROWTH
2	ACROSS INCOME GROUPS.
3	(a) Definitions.—In this section:
4	(1) Bureau.—The term "Bureau" means the
5	Bureau of Economic Analysis of the Department of
6	Commerce.
7	(2) Gross domestic product analysis.—
8	The term "gross domestic product analysis"—
9	(A) means a quarterly or annual analysis
10	conducted by the Bureau with respect to the
11	gross domestic product of the United States;

13	(B) includes a revision prepared by the
14	Bureau of an analysis described in subpara-
15	graph (A).
16	(3) RECENT ESTIMATE.—The term "recent es-
17	timate" means the most recent estimate described in
18	subsection (b) that is available on the date on which

20	estimate is to be included is conducted.
21	(b) Inclusion in Reports.—Not later than 1 year
22	after the date of the enactment of this Act, in each gross
23	domestic product analysis conducted by the Bureau, the
24	Bureau shall include a recent estimate of, with respect to
25	specific percentile groups of income, the total amount that
26	was added to the economy of the United States during

- 1 the period to which the recent estimate pertains, including
- 2 in—
- 3 (1) each of the 10 deciles of income; and
- 4 (2) the highest 1 percent of income.
- 5 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
- are authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Com-
