To amend section 1115 of title 31, United States Code, to amend the description of how performance goals are achieved, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Performance Enhance-
- 5 ment Reform Act".
