## A BILL

To amend the Department of State Authorities Act, Fiscal Year 2017 to modify the biannual report on overseas capital construction projects.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Embassy Construction
- 5 Accountability Act of 2022".

1	SEC. 2. MODIFICATIONS TO BIANNUAL REPORT ON OVER-
2	SEAS CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS.
3	(a) In General.—Subsection (a) of section 118 of
4	the Department of State Authorities Act, Fiscal Year
5	2017 (Public Law 114–323; 22 U.S.C. 304) is amended—
6	(1) by striking "and the Committees on Appro-
7	priations" and inserting ", the Committees on Ap-
8	propriations"; and
9	(2) by inserting after "House of Representa-
10	tives," the following: ", and the Committee on
11	Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the
12	Senate and the Committee on Oversight and Reform
13	of the House of Representatives".
14	(b) Contents.—Subsection (b) of such section is
15	amended—
16	(1) in paragraph (2), by adding at the end be-
17	fore the period the following: "and, when the current
18	cost estimate exceeds the initial cost estimate by 15
19	percent or more, an explanation of the causal or con-
20	tributing factors resulting in the increased estimated
21	cost, as well as how the Department plans to miti-
22	gate the risk of further potential cost increases";

24	(2) by adding at the end the following:
25	"(10) If the current date of estimated comple-
26	tion reported under paragraph (9) exceeds the date

1	of estimated completion reported under paragraph
2	(8) by 180 days or more, a description of the causal
3	or contributing factors that resulted in the revised
4	estimated completion date, as well as how the De-
5	partment plans to mitigate the operational impacts
6	of the delay.
7	"(11) Whether the Department has issued a
8	stop-work order or suspension-of-work order on any
9	component or subset of the project, the expected du-
10	ration of any such order, and the justification for
11	any such order.".
