As we have discussed, the oil and gas industry is focused on enhancing our reporting around climate and is undertaking a number of efforts in this space. In particular, our Executive Committee recently approved a reporting template that standardizes a core set of specific indicators with detailed corresponding definitions to prompt like-for-like reporting on GHGs from one company to the next. This work is unique in that it covers the entire breadth of the industry and is applicable to company-wide reporting for assets located across a company's operations. The work was also informed through consultation with the financial services industry.

In addition, we have been engaging with the SEC on their climate related reporting work including a set of comments to their request for information. The attached comment letter also includes the reporting template. Our comments focus on work already being done within the industry and the need to consider the importance of materiality in their deliberations. We also highlight the benefit of leveraging existing efforts in this dynamic space as well deference to industry efforts.

Needless to say, there is a lot going on in this space and more to come. My team will continue to work with yours and will reach out to set up some time to go over our template and the comments we submitted to the SEC in the coming weeks.
