**BALTIMORE (November 9, 2017)** – Against the backdrop of the current Administration's all-out assault on environmental safeguards, particularly on curbing methane emissions from the oil and gas industry, the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP), the nation's foremost civil rights organization, Clean Air Task Force (CATF) and the National Medical Association (NMA) are releasing a first-ever report on the growing threats to the health of African American communities across the country from airborne oil and gas pollution. Our November 14<sup>th</sup> panel will include discussion from experts on the quantification of these elevated health risks which millions of African Americans face.

**What**: The study, entitled *Fumes Across the Fence-Line*, is jointly published by researchers at CATF and NAACP, and quantifies the health risks, including cancer and respiratory illnesses, which are caused by emissions from the natural gas supply chain. The disproportionate health impacts are the result of decades of building fossil fuel facilities close to the properties of African American and low-income people, or "fence-line communities", and the threat is growing as the natural gas industry has boomed in recent years. The study also examines the toxic and hazardous emissions from oil refineries.
