The Climate Leadership Council (CLC) announced its foundation in June 2017 via an advertisement in the Wall Street Journal. It is an international research and advocacy organisation whose mission is to mobilise global leaders around equitable climate solutions. It develops and promotes new policy frameworks based on carbon dividends.

BP was one of the founding corporate members – along with Exxon, Conoco, AECOM, Allianz, AT&T, Exelon, First Solar, GM, Johnson & Johnson, MetLife and P&G.

Membership has now risen to 18 corporate members, including Shell and Total.

The attached short document (6 pages) provides an overview of the CLC and its plan – and a brief bio of Ted Halstead.

In summary the CLC are advocating for 4 things;

- 1. A gradually rising fee on carbon dioxide emissions
- 2. The proceeds from this carbon fee should be returned to the American people on an equal and quarterly basis as a carbon dividend
- 3. Adjustments for the carbon content of both imports and exports would protect American competitiveness and disadvantage nations without a carbon price, encouraging them to adopt carbon pricing of their own.
- 4. The elimination of regulations that are no longer necessary with carbon fee

Note that James Baker is heavily involved in the CLC – and he has a long history with BP and chaired the Baker Panel post Texas City.
