Hello Mike,

Tomorrow, February 26, we will publish our trade association report "*Our participation in trade associations: climate.*" It is an assessment of the alignment between BP's position on climate change and the energy transition and the views held by our trade associations, including the American Petroleum Institute (API). We want you to hear about this publication from us first.

Our trade association review demonstrates API is partially aligned with BP's climate positions. A copy of the report is attached. I ask that you not share this more broadly until it is published tomorrow morning at 7:00 a.m. ET.
