Representatives from 50 energy companies and organizations met today with "senior leaders" of President-elect Donald Trump's transition team in Washington, Jennifer Drogus, a spokeswoman for the National Association of Manufacturers, told POLITICO.

The meeting, which included oil, gas, coal, nuclear, wind, solar and companies throughout the energy supply chain, focused on how to "leverage the nation's diverse energy resources to improve the economy, create jobs and make manufacturing more competitive" as well as the need to continue investing in energy infrastructure, according to Drogus.

Participants also discussed two NAM white papers on the organization's environmental and energy priorities in the next administration. Recommendations in those documents include additional investment in carbon capture and sequestration technologies, expediting the permitting process for liquefied natural gas exports and a "comprehensive update" of environmental statutes.

NAM said Trump's team had requested the meeting, which was held at the group's headquarters. Trump's transition team did not immediately respond to requests for comment.
