Here is a powerpoint put out by the State of Washington on the Clean Air Rule that will impact our Cherry Point refinery.

Here are a couple of key points:
It is a cap and lower plan - meaning that emissions are lowered every three years over a 20-year plan.

There are three ways to come into compliance: reduce emissions, implement greenhouse gas reductions projects or buy credits.

Over time, the emission allowances (credits) will be phased out over time with only 5% of emission goals coming from allowances by 2035.
