Erin and I briefed ACP a few hours ago on bp's new direction, and they provided some updates from their end.

I'll start with the news.

Updates from ACP:

Any other ideas? They're hoping a mixed-portfolio member such as bp will consider doing an op-ed (either on our own or with them) talking about what happened in Texas, what lessons we can take away for the future of energy and power grids, and what we're working toward with our ambition.

- I told them we could discuss internally and get back to them, but I also mentioned that we've been inclined to stay out of the fray on this issue.

About our presentation: I used a shortened version of our "stump speech" slide deck to explain our purpose, ambitions and strategy, after which Erin summarized where things stand with our wind and solar portfolios and provided some additional details on how we're looking to expand in those spaces.

ACP feedback: Stacey and Greg sounded excited about bp's direction and mentioned that ACP would be happy to amplify future announcements of low-carbon energy deals/projects and even bp divestments from hydrocarbon assets.
