Hi Wendy,

Thank you for your time last week and great to run into you earlier today. I wanted to follow up with some additional information about the exciting opportunities we have on the docket for the 6th annual Arctic Encounter (AES) in Seattle on April 25-26, 2019. AES 2019 will take place for the third year running at the <u>Bell Harbor International Conference Center</u> on Pier 66 in downtown Seattle. I've attached a few photos of this premier venue, which includes 100,000 square feet of event space featuring surround sound presentation capabilities and 180-degree views of the Olympic Mountains, Mt. Rainier, Puget Sound's Elliott Bay and the downtown skyline.

The 2018 Arctic Encounter drew over 100 speakers, 32 sponsors, 11 media partners, 13 guest performers, and artist-exhibitors to Seattle to discuss and debate emerging challenges and solutions in Arctic security. The 2018 AES also featured the <u>Arctic Youth Initiative</u> photography installments, the *Far North Fashion Show* on the red carpet during the keynote seated dinner, and artist-exhibitor sales of beautiful and unique artwork from the north (Note: All artists keep 100% of proceeds). We were thrilled to welcome over 300 participants from across Alaska, the U.S., and 15+ nations to the 2018 convening.

In October 2018 we hosted the first Arctic Encounter Iceland in Reykjavík with our co-hosts: the Government of Greenland, U.S. Senator Lisa Murkowski, and the Wilson Center. And just last month we hosted the first Arctic Encounter London in collaboration with UK-based think tank, PRPI. We were honored to welcome representatives from 20 nations, including all 8 Arctic states, and 7 members of the UK Parliament as participants.

The sixth annual Arctic Encounter Seattle will build off of this momentum and engage domestic and international policymakers, business leaders, nationally recognized artists and scientists, and more. We will engage the theme of innovation in the Arctic, specifically disruptive business and private investment models, energy and power, climate research, national security, infrastructure, groundbreaking economic and trade models, and popular media trends impacting the Far North.

As a global leader in energy production and other technological innovation sectors, we would be thrilled to welcome BP as a sponsor and participant. Attached is a document outlining all of the ways in which sponsors engage in AES, including speaking roles. Should BP be interested in participating as a top level sponsor, I would like to offer up a speaking role on a closing VIP panel on the main stage with national policymakers, likely a top level executive from Alaska Airlines as our 2017-2019 Platinum Sponsor (TBC), and 1-2 international leaders (likely an Ambassador - TBC).
