It was a pleasure to meet you and Isabel in New York earlier this month. Thank you for your time and thoughtful insights as always. I promised to get back to on a number of points that we discussed.

You raised methane emission standards within Europe. I can confirm that we support setting such standards, introducing them over a limited time-period which allows producers and shippers to take action as needed.

Our industry argues strongly for the benefits of gas over coal, and we need to clearly demonstrate that to our customers, along with a progressive road map to minimising fugitives and incentivising differentiated gas. We would like to work with you and other willing parties to do this.

We also discussed methane measurement. You asked whether, as we begin to have data based on measurement, we can share that data publicly. We believe the answer is yes - as and when it is integrated into the protocols we use for our external reporting, we intend for it to form part of the metrics we publish on greenhouse gas and methane emissions performance.
