Thank you for your July 14, 2011, letter confirming our agreement on next steps in the Committee's investigation into "wrongful foreclosures and other abuses by mortgage servicing companies."¹ As we agreed, I withdrew my motion for subpoenas at the July 14th hearing because you agreed to obtain the information covered by my subpoenas through joint document requests to the ten mortgage servicing companies we identified. We also agreed to contact other committees to determine whether they have sent document requests to these mortgage servicing companies and, if so, to determine whether we might be able to obtain some of the information covered by the subpoenas directly from them.

My staff has now consulted with the Committee on Veterans' Affairs, the Committee on Financial Services, and their appropriate subcommittees, and they report that the documents covered by the subpoenas were neither requested nor obtained by them.

As a result, I have attached for your review and our joint signatures the ten letters to the mortgage servicing companies we identified seeking the documents covered by the subpoenas. I thank you for working with me on this matter and look forward to a thorough and bipartisan investigation of these widespread and illegal actions against our nation's men and women in uniform.
