## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Recess Appointment

5 Restoration Act".

## 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.

- 7 Section 5503 of title 5, United States Code, is
- 8 amended by adding at the end the following:

"(c)(1) Payment for services may not be made from
the Treasury of the United States to an individual appointed to fill a vacancy that is by law required to be filled
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, until
the appointee has been confirmed by the Senate, unless
the individual was appointed while the Senate was adjourned for at least 10 days.

8 "(2) For purposes of this subsection, a day of ad9 journment of the Senate is a day on which the Senate does
10 not meet.".
